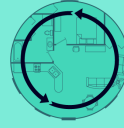


5 WAYS TO COOL YOUR YURT

Yurts are circular, which means air moves about naturally because of their shape. Round shapes also have less surface area than rectangular ones, which also helps.



USE THESE STRATEGIES FOR STAYING COOL IN YOUR YURT:

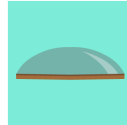
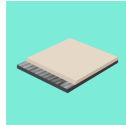
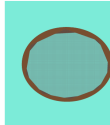
1. CHOOSE YOUR SITE FOR SHADE.

Where you build your yurt will heavily affect your efforts to cool it. Choose a spot that is shaded during mid-day and afternoon in summer if at all possible.

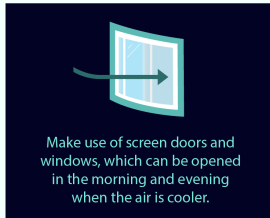


2. CUSTOMIZE FOR COOL.

Pacific Yurts offers customizable features, such as operable dome skylights, shade screens, reflective insulation, and tinted domes – all to keep the place comfortable.



3. MAXIMIZE AIR FLOW.



4. INSTALL AN AC UNIT AND/OR FAN.



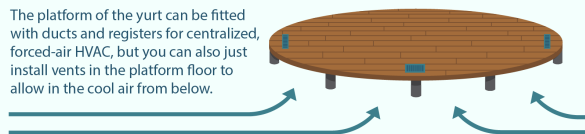
We offer a convenience panel that accommodates a traditional window unit for AC, or you can install a ductless heat pump, which does not require any special modifications to the yurt.



You can also install ceiling fans or simply use a pedestal fan.

5. BRING THE COOL AIR UP.

The platform of the yurt can be fitted with ducts and registers for centralized, forced-air HVAC, but you can also just install vents in the platform floor to allow in the cool air from below.
